Our Adoption Process

Once you have made the decision that you would like to adopt one of our available pets, we will want you to have a meet and greet with the pet. If you have current pets in your household, we do require that you bring them to meet the adoptable. This only applies to dogs as cats can be stressed in a veterinary environment. If there are children and/or other people in your household, please bring them as well. To set up a meet-and-greet, please contact us at the clinic or email our adoption coordinator directly at (adoptions@coynevetcare.com).

Once our adoption coordinator reviews all applications and meets with the families, they will be in contact with you once they have made their decision. If selected for the adoption, our coordinator will set up a day for you to come in and finalize the adoption and send you home with your new furrever friend!

What's Included In Our Adoption Fee

Our adoption fee is \$275 for canines and \$150 for felines. The following is what is included in that fee:

<i>*Boosters required for pets post-adoption are the financial responsibility of the adopter.</i>	

In addition to the adoption fee, heartworm preventatives must be purchased at the time of the adoption. Canines are required to leave with 6-months of heartworm prevention and felines are to be 3-months.

_____ The spay/neuter must be done by six (6) months of age. If not completed in the allotted time, any fees associated with the procedure will be the responsibility of the adopter. Pets over six (6) months of age at the time of adoption must be spayed/neutered before leaving the clinic.

_____ Coyne Veterinary Center cannot guarantee the weight, breed, size, and/or temperament of adopted pets; therefore, they are not liable for any injury or damage of property.
